



About the survey (In field: November)



More than half of organizations require or plan to require a vaccination


57% More than half of organizations will require a vaccination for their employees if the mandates go into effect

Offer testing or plan to test employees regularly




19% of organizations offer or plan to offer testing to vaccinated employees

About half of employers who have decided will cover the testing costs and 4 in 5 will test employees weekly





Few employers with mandates believe that it has helped with recruitment and retention


How frequently have vaccine mandates been a factor that helps with employee recruitment or retention?






More than half of employers will require new hires to be vaccinated as a condition of employment if the mandates go into effect

What type of incentives does your organization offer or plan to offer to encourage employees to get vaccinated for COVID-19?



What is the approximate percentage of employees working remotely at your organization? What do you expect the percentage will be by Q1, 2022?



More remote-capable workers have returned to the workplace


Have your remote-capable workers returned to the workplace?

or plan to require masks to be worn indoors




