Furthermore, as portfolio companies are frequently destined for sale, DARCstar Private Equity 2023 includes pre-negotiated terms for an extended reporting period of up to six years post-sale. This safeguard encompasses acts and omissions by directors and officers (and other insured persons such as employees) during the period of private equity firm ownership.

- Expanded insured persons: Definition includes directors and officers at an investment holding company.
- Comprehensive employee coverage: All employees covered, removing limitations often found in other D&O policies.


