7.	Is there documented evidence of a credible investigation being conducted?	
8.	Were there regular check ins with key stakeholders (those conducting the investigation and leadership) as the investigation progressed?	
9.	Were errors in process made or avoided?	
10.	Were measures taken to ensure confidentiality was maintained throughout the investigation?	
11.	Was the allegation of abuse response plan followed?	
12.	If not, what happened?	
13.	What went well?	
14.	What could have gone better?	
15.	Were impacted staff provided with adequate emotional support as needed?	
16.	Are there any training opportunities?	
17.	Does the response plan need refinement?
